OPEN RIDERS Please Note:

All participants in an Open Competition, INCLUDING PONY CLUB MEMBERS, must sign a Public Liability Declaration Form

Participants do not need to pay \$10/day or fill in the Day Participant Waiver (lower part of combined form) if they are a current member of:

-PCAV -HRCV -EA/EV -Interstate Pony Club -AHSA -AERA -SHCA

- or can provide proof that they are covered by Person Liability Insurance Cover of at least \$10,000,000

Proof of Current Membership must be copied and sent with entry, or be presented to the Secretary's Office prior to commencing riding.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules <http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au/?MenuID=publications%2F10854%2F0%2CRules%5F%28inc%5FDressage%5FTests%29%5Fand%5FRegulations%5Fand%5FGuides%2F10917%2F29455%2F0>.
2. PCV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office prior to riding.
3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate.
4. Late entries, if accepted, will incur an additional cost of \$10 per class.
5. The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
6. Competitors may ride a maximum of two horses. One horse, one rider. The committee of management of the event have the sole discretion to decide the number of entries accepted. **Entries will be limited for all events.**
7. Open riders must present a Current PCAV, EA/EV, AHSA, AERA, HRC AV, or SHCA Membership Cards must be presented to the Secretaries Office before riding. **No Card, No Ride.**
8. All Open competitors must sign a day attendance form and return with entry.
9. OPEN RIDERS who do not have adequate Insurance Cover must complete the Day Participation Form and pay \$10.
10. All riders must present to **gear check** before competing in **each phase**.
11. **All riders** must wear medical armbands by ALL competitors and displayed on the upper arm.
12. Helmets: must comply with PCV 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn, refer PCV 'Helmet' hyperlink below. Spot checks may occur, incorrect helmet will mean elimination.

13. Competitor numbers – the organizing committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers; body numbers will be available at the event. Non-pony club members, or those without current pony club cards will be required to pay a \$5 refundable deposit on body number.
14. Pony club riders to wear full pony club uniform. Open riders may wear HRC AV uniform, pony club uniform, formal riding attire or neat polo/rugby style top or jacket. Jodhpurs or moleskins must be worn and in the colour of banana, beige, white or fawn.
15. Horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
16. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
17. PCV Lunging Policy applies. Lunging must take place in the confined area designated exclusively for lunging by the organizing committee. At a competition only the competitor may ride or lunge his horse or pony with the exception of riders under the age of 14 years. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
18. **Dogs and pets are prohibited and will result in the elimination of the competitor. This is inclusive of those supporters who bring dogs or pets, competitors will be eliminated by association.**
19. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules are per PCV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
20. Neither the organizing committee of this competition nor the PCV, or the Pioneer Park Reserve accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
21. PCV By-Laws
 - Stabling and yards should be of solid construction.
 - The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted at Pony Club Event
 - Electric tape can be used as a top line or as a "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
