Dressage tests as per PCV dressage book 2013. Dressage tests to commence at 9am on the day. All open and pony club riders to do following nominated graded dressage test:

Grade 3A & 3C (arena size 20x60) Grade 4A & 4C, 5A & 5C, Grade 6A (arena size 20x40).

**Ribbons to 6th place in Pony Club, 4th place in Open.
Trophies for Winners in each section.**

OPEN RIDERS

Participants in events organized by PCV Clubs, who are not current financial members of a PCV Club, or who do not have any other approved insurance in place, are deemed to be 'Day Participants' of the event/activity on completion of the Day Participant Waiver.

Participants must provide proof of current membership or Insurance cover to avoid paying the \$10 per day Participant Fee (*EA must be a direct member, not just a member of an EA affiliated Club). Riders without adequate Insurance Liability cover must complete and pay \$10 per day fee.

Protection is afforded to the Day Participant under the PCV Public Liability policy, only whilst participating in activities organized and/or run by the PCV club at that event, where they are liable for causing bodily injury or property damage to others, excluding whilst travelling to and from such event. By completing the Day Participant Waiver form, you agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of the PCV and any Rules of the Event.

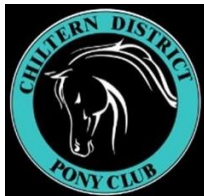
Adequate Insurance liability

Participants do not need to pay \$10/day or fill in the Day Participant Waiver (lower part of combined form) if they are a current member of:

- Pony Club Victoria;
- Equestrian Australia* (EA);
- HRCV;
- an Inter State Pony Club;
- Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHSA);
- Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA); or
- can provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000.00

Conditions of Entry

1. Before riding: PCV cards must be inspected at the secretary's office. All compulsory forms and Open Rider insurance details must have been submitted.
2. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
3. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
4. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
5. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of [PCV Handbook](#) of By-laws multiple horse rules.
6. Complying [helmets](#) must be worn, spot checks may occur.
7. Gear Check: **required for all riders before each phase.**
8. **Medical Armbands:** must be worn by all competitors on the upper arm.
9. Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. ***Competitors supply their own numbers.***
10. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
11. **Dogs are prohibited without exception.**
12. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
13. Lunging is NOT permitted at this event.
14. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
15. Pony Club competitors must be in full uniform for presentation.
16. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
17. Portable yards must be of solid construction as per PCV rules. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted. Electric tape can be used as a top line "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
