Entry Fees:

Pony Club Horse Trials – Grades 1 to 6 - \$40

Open Horse Trials - Grades 1 to 5 - \$50 Plus \$10 per day fee for riders without specified

insurance - see below.

Pony Club Combined Training - Grade 3, 4, 5 and 6 - \$30

Pony Club Supercross – Grades 1 to 5 - \$30

*(riders may enter any combination of HT, CT and SC, but will only ride one dressage test, one show jumping round and one cross country. Only PC riders who are graded the same for HT & CT may enter both competitions.)

Camping (un-powered) - \$10 per site/per night, to be paid with entry.

Horse Yards (limited) - \$10 per yard, to be paid with entry.

Late entries, if accepted will incur a \$20 fee.

(If direct depositing a copy of the receipt must accompany entry form).

Open Riders please note:

All participants in an Open Competition, **including Pony Club Members**, must sign and provide a copy of the <u>PCAV Liability Declaration Form & Day Participant Waiver</u> (if applicable). Participants do not need to pay \$10/day or fill in the Day Participant Waiver, if they are a current member of: PCV, HRCAV, EA/EV, Interstate Pony Club, AHSA, AERA, SHCA or can provide proof that they are covered by Personal Liability Insurance Cover of at least \$10,000,000 – however proof of current membership is required and a copy must be sent with entry.

Prizes:

Horse Trials (Pony Club) – Embroidered Rug for 1st place and sashes to 6th. (No equals for 1st) Horse Trials (Open) – Prize for 1st place and sashes to 4th. (No equals for 1st) CT and Supercross (Pony Club) – Prize for 1st place and sashes to 6th. (No equal placings)

Show Jumping Grade 4, 5 and 6 will be held on Saturday afternoon.

Grading Guidelines: Grade 6 a true beginner, able to ride independently.

^{*}Brush fences must be regularly maintained and allow horses to pass readily through the brush and not present a 'solid' element to the fence. The material used must be such that the risk of injury to horses is a small as possible. Thick stems and sharp ends after trimming/cutting must be avoided. It is recommended that the back of the brush box be 5cms lower than the front

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. Open Riders (including Pony Club open riders)

- a. Everybody fills in the PCV Liability Declaration Form
- b. \$10 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member* of EV/EA; HRCAV; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. *Must produce proof with entry. If not provided you will have to pay insurance at c below.
- c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the <u>PCV Day Participant Waiver</u>
- d. PCV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.

PCV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCV Rules may be left uninsured.

- 2. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
- 3. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 4. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 5. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
- 6. Complying helmets must worn, spot checks may occur. See PCV rules here: http://www.ponyclubaustralia.com.au/Portals/184/Documents/Policies/PCA%20helmets%202018.pdf?ver=2018-03-16-233848-947
- 7. Gear Check: required for all riders before each phase.
- 8. Medical Armbands: must be worn by all competitors.
- 9. Riders under eight years of age may not compete in the Horse Trials competition, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- 10. Competitor numbers the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. However, body numbers must be used for cross-country. Body numbers will be available at the event.
- 11. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
- 12. Dogs and other pets are prohibited without exception.
- 13. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
- 14. PCV Lunging Policy applies. Lunging is not permitted at this competition.
- 15. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- 16. Stabling and portable yards must be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted. Electric tape can be used as a top line "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
