Conditions of Entry:

Entering this clinic constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

- All riders must wear approved helmets as specified in [PCA Gear Rules](#).
- All riders must wear approved, riding boots and a medical armband. must be worn
- Jumping to be at your graded level, cards must be presented.
- Horse abuse rules will apply as per the PCV hand book.
- Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- Neither PCV, the organizer, instructor nor anyone acting on their behalf, accepts any liability for any accidents, injury or illness to horse, owners, ground spectators, or any person or property.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to: cancel any class or event; divide any class; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- Organizers reserve the right to change times where deemed necessary. e.g to manage wet conditions
- No refund will be given without medical or vet certificate.
- Lunging will not be permitted
- Dogs to remain on leads at all times
- Alcohol Policy: As per PCV rules.
- CAMPING/YARDS: fees are to be paid with entry.
- Stabling and yards should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted. Electric tape can be used as a top line "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
- All open competitors must complete the liability declaration form. This form can be down-loaded from www.ponyclubvic.org.au
- * \$10 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member* of EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. *Must produce proof.
- Riders without adequate Insurance Cover must pay \$10 per day for Liability and complete the Participant Waiver.
