### Conditions of Entry

1. Moyhu Pony Club Horse Trials to be conducted under current PCV rules.
2. **Dogs are allowed but MUST be on a leash at all times and not allowed near competition area**
3. Neither the organizing committee of this event nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property. The organizing committee reserves the right to: cancel any class or event; divide any class; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
4. XC jump steward: each club must provide 1 Steward for every 3 riders or part thereof.
5. Queries, protests, horse abuse rules as per PCV Handbook of by-Laws.
6. Only competitors may ride on the grounds during event.
7. Entering this competition constitutes acceptance of PCV rules.
8. Alcohol Policy: As per PCV rules.
9. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate.
10. Grading: after close of entries, if a rider's grade changes, unless there is a scratching in the new grade, the rider will have to compete H/C in the grade entered.
11. Uniform: Pony Club uniform, or Open Entries: jacket; shirt & tie; beige, cream, or white jodhpurs; or HRC AV Uniform
12. Competitor numbers: the organizing committee will pre-allocate numbers; **Back numbers will be supplied to Pony club riders, Open riders to supply their own number holder and are to be worn in all phases of event.**
13. Horses must be at least four years of age, no stallions, colts or rigs.
14. **Riders must be eight years of age or older to compete in HT event.**
15. ATTENDANCE CARDS: Pony Club cards to be handed in when collecting back numbers.
16. Competitors entering more than one horse must nominate an order of preference, as entries may be limited to one horse, depending on numbers.
17. Cross Country course will be closed from **Midnight Friday 1st March 2019**. Any riders found on the course during the 2 weeks leading up to the competition may be eliminated
18. Gear check: all riders must present at least 20 minutes before each phase.
19. Open riders follow pony club riders in appropriate grades.
20. Medical armbands must be worn for all phases.
21. Helmets: Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in [PCA Gear Rules](#).
22. Lunging is not permitted.
23. **OPEN RIDERS: Please Note** - All participants in an Open Competition, INCLUDING PONY CLUB MEMBERS, must sign a Public Liability Declaration Form.
24. CAMPING/YARDS: If fees are not paid with entry, persons found camping/using yards without camping/yard permit on the evening before or on day of competition, will be charged double fees for camping and yards. This will be checked.
25. Stabling and yards should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted. Electric tape can be used as a top line "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
